Applications can be *no longer, than* 3000 words, not including title, researcher name(s)/qualifications/organization, references, or expense table.

Applications should include the following sections:

1. TITLE
2. Researcher or Research Team (name, qualifications, organization/institution)
3. *Please note that if the PI of a grant is not Doctorally prepared with a research intensive degree it may be helpful to find a Doctorally prepared nurse mentor to include on your application team.*
4. Introduction
5. Literature review (synthesis) and identification of knowledge gap
6. Study Purpose
7. Research Problem /Study Aims
8. Research Question(s) or Hypothesis
9. Informed Consent
10. Methodology
To include: Sample (recruitment), setting, data collection procedure, data storage, and proposed data analysis
11. Results: Implications for clinical or diagnostic reasoning, use of standardized nursing language, or knowledge development
12. References
13. Budget table
This table is to include, at a minimum:
 - Description of expenses for which you are seeking funding
 - Justification of expenses within the context of this investigation
 - Total Cost of Budget
 - Grant money may be used for dissemination of your findings outside of NANDA-I, but only for an accepted presentation of the research on nursing diagnosis or standardized language
 - *Please note:* Grant money may *not* be used to pay for an academic course, or for travel to or registration for the NANDA-I conference
