## **Guidelines for the NANDA Foundation Grant submission 2023**

Required elements for the submission include (8 pages maximum; PDF document):

- 1. Title of the proposal
- Authors and affiliations (universities, or organizations where author(s) work; city, country)
- 3. Short bio of the research team involved in the project that reflect capability/ability to accomplish the proposed research
- 4. Introduction to the research project
- 5. Literature review/synthesis
- 6. Problem statement and study framework
- 7. Research questions/hypothesis/aims
- 8. Methodology: sample (size, type, selection process); data collection; data analysis, etc.
- 9. Ethics/Human Subjects Approval
- 10.Research impact/significance: how will the results influence nursing language, nursing knowledge, education, practice, research, and/or policy
- 11.References (APA style)
- 12. Plan for Dissemination of Results
- 13. Project timeline (table or Gantt Chart format; projects with a duration of more than two years will not be reviewed)
- 14.Budget (table format) (**please note the Foundation will not fund the following:** tuition fees, fees for paid for open access publishing, regular computer office and computer equipment, travel expenses and conference fees. If in doubt, please ask us a question by email)

**NOTE**: Submitters should emphasize items **4 through 7**. Proposals not meeting these Guidelines will not be reviewed.
