

Guidelines for the NANDA Foundation Grant submission 2023

Required elements for the submission include **(8 pages maximum; PDF document)**:

1. Title of the proposal
2. Authors and affiliations (universities, or organizations where author(s) work; city, country)
3. Short bio of the research team involved in the project that reflect capability/ability to accomplish the proposed research
- 4. Introduction to the research project**
- 5. Literature review/synthesis**
- 6. Problem statement and study framework**
- 7. Research questions/hypothesis/aims**
8. Methodology: sample (size, type, selection process); data collection; data analysis, etc.
9. Ethics/Human Subjects Approval
10. Research impact/significance: how will the results influence nursing language, nursing knowledge, education, practice, research, and/or policy
11. References (APA style)
12. Plan for Dissemination of Results
13. Project timeline (table or Gantt Chart format; projects with a duration of more than two years will not be reviewed)
14. Budget (table format) (**please note the Foundation will not fund the following:** *tuition fees, fees for paid for open access publishing, regular computer office and computer equipment, travel expenses and conference fees. If in doubt, please ask us a question by email*)

NOTE: Submitters should emphasize items **4 through 7**. Proposals not meeting these Guidelines will not be reviewed.
