The Fellows represent nursing leaders with expertise in standardized nursing language within the areas of education, administration, practice, informatics and research. They include: association/organization executives; chancellors, deans and university professors; clinical nurse specialists and nurse practitioners; nurse consultants; journal/book editors and authors; researchers and entrepreneurs.

NANDA-I Fellowship recognizes the accomplishments of these individuals within the standardized nursing language arena, and the nursing profession as a whole.
